Commissioner Carlson, Commissioner Mayo, and Commissioner Thurlow were present at a regular meeting beginning at 8:00 a.m. The minutes were approved as printed. Account payables in the amount of \$1,845.01 were reviewed and approved by the Board.

Ronnie Tremblay, Highway Administrator, met with the Board to give the weekly report. Hi-Plains Sand has agreed to mix the asphalt for Clay County again this year, but it will cost an additional \$3.00 per ton for it to be made. This will be an estimated increase of \$36,000 for the 2018 year. The Department did a half mile of dirt work on 20th Road, worked on Walnut Rd, hauled rock, and bladed roads. Mr. Tremblay reported that one of the County dump trucks was involved in a two-vehicle accident on Friday afternoon.

Marvin VanBlaricon, EMS Director, met with the Board to give the weekly report. Repairs have been completed on Emergency Unit 1905 in Salina. The tires have been replaced and aligned on Emergency Unit 1903. The batteries for the EMS pagers are having to be replaced and several of the clips have broken off so they are purchasing carrying cases to wear on their belts.

Arnie Knoettgen, County Maintenance, met with the Board to provide repair estimates for the handicap ramp drainage issues. The following estimates were reviewed:

Mel's Pump & Plumbing – Plumbing - \$3,742.44

Griggs Electric - \$971.66 – Electrical

Commissioner Thurlow made the motion to accept both bids for repairs to the drain at the bottom of the handicap ramp. Commissioner Mayo seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The drain repairs will be paid out of the Courthouse Maintenance Fund. The Board stated that they will be making a decision next week on the stone repair and cleaning of the stone on the Courthouse.

The Board signed an Event Approval for an employee of the County Clerk's Office to attend training in Topeka, Kansas.

Pam Kemp, Emergency Manager, met with the Board to have the Chairman sign the Incident Management Team Renewal that is required to be sent to the State of Kansas.

Danny Mesalles, County Appraiser, met with the Board to report that the Personal Property values will be mailed out next week. Mr. Mesalles has certified Real Estate values to the County Clerk for the 2018 Tax Year. Mr. Mesalles asked the Board if they would approve to have the new County logo digitized at Gate 9 at a cost of \$30 so that it can be stitched on shirts. Commissioner Mayo stated that we need to contact Connie Paronto with Connie's Creation to see if she would be interested also.

Chuck Dunn, Sheriff, met with the Board to give the weekly report. Sheriff Dunn discussed several fires that happened this past weekend.

The Board adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
