LIST OF ITEMS WE ACCEPT FOR RECYCLING

Cardboard, paper, newspaper, magazines, reading books, Plastics (with a triangle and a number), glass of all colors, tin cans, aluminum cans, aluminum foil, wearable or repairable clothes, chemical jugs (triple rinsed) we do accept E-Waste which means any electronic with a cord or takes batteries there is a charge for CRT'S (which are the older style of TV'S and monitors with the big backs) we accept shrink wrap, super sacks (feed).

HHW means household hazardous waste (a byproduct that is toxic and presents a potential threat to people and the environment) the HHW Facility accepts all types of paints (latex, oil base), stains & varnishes, household cleaners, poisons, weed killers (farm & home), bug sprays, light bulbs, aerosols (empty or full cans), used oil, oil filters, antifreeze, batteries (AA to car, boat batteries) for businesses there is a charge on certain products.

ITEMS NOT FOR RECYCLING

Certain items are not for recycling like styrofoam, motor oil containers, wet papers, wet or moldy clothes, animal feed sacks with plastic liner, powder donut bags, Kleenex, paper towels used paper plates, dirty diapers, razor blades, porcelain dishes. Products containing Freon (refrigerators, air conditioners) will be under solid waste price same with mattresses & box springs.
